Jeanne Smith

Jeanne Smith has been working as a Community Habilitation Specialist for The Center for Family Support since 2007 and has developed a strong and trusting relationship with our service recipients during this time. I feel she has displayed the core competencies in her efforts with our individuals.

Competency Area F: Building and Maintaining Relationships

Jeanne encourages the individual she works with to maintain relationships. Jeanne will help rehearse situations with the individual before they occur to lessen anxiety and to help her have more selfassurance. Most recently, Jeanne has been focusing on discussing work related situations. Jeanne also is instrumental in helping this individual create and maintain relationships in her local community through volunteer opportunities and involvement with her parish. Jeanne also helps our recipient to advocate for herself and rehearses ways to communicate more effectively when she is feeling overwhelmed, etc. in social situations with family, friends, colleagues, etc.



<u>Competency Area V: Supporting Active Participation in the</u> <u>Community</u>

One such relationship that has become very important in the individuals life is with a local cat shelter. Our service recipient loves animals and Jeanne has helped to connect her with this volunteer opportunity. At least once a week, the individual socializes with cats that are waiting to be adopted . Jeanne also supports and assists the individual to be an active member in her local church parish. Jeanne helps her to donate food items, clothing, and participate in other events that help give back to the community (especially around the holi-days!)

Competency Area O: Promoting Positive Behavior & Supports

A specific situation in which Jeanne has demonstrated this skill was when she realized how environmental factors influence her service recipient's behavior. The individual that Jeanne works with often has great anxiety when using a public restroom and it was always assumed she just preferred the privacy of her home restroom. Initially, Jeanne would ensure that the individual always used the bathroom at home before they went out. However, this was not always possible and there were times that the individual had to use the bathroom in public. Jeanne devised a plan to de-sensitize her service recipient to using public restrooms, in doing so she discovered that the individuals fears were that the lights would go out on her (on a timer), the toilet would clog and overflow, and/or the flush of a specific bowl scared her. These concerns were quelled by Jeanne, who will stand in front of the light sensor (if there is one), and Jeanne always flushes the bowl for the individual PRIOR to her using the bathroom to let her see and hear how the flush will be. The individual still has some restrooms which intimidate her; however, great progress has been made thanks to Jeanne's intuition and finding out what were the triggers of the individual's fears/behavior.

Competency Area P: Supporting Health & Wellness

The individual that Jeanne works with has been on a mission to lose weight and follow a healthy, low-carb lifestyle. Jeanne helps her to explore new recipes and works with the family to decide what nights she can help the individual make a new meal. We brainstormed ways that we can make this goal more enticing and decided to try the Pinterest app. Jeanne is intimidated by technology, but put the needs of her individual first and sat with me and the individual and took the time to download and learn the app so she could then move forward with helping the individual. Another way that Jeanne supports this individual's wellness is by helping her to stay mindful of hoarding tendencies. Jeanne is patient and tolerant and listens to her individual.

In conclusion, Jeanne and her service recipient take advantage of the holiday spirit and goodwill towards others within their community. They volunteer together year-round, but a few specific things they did this month were: visited the cat shelter and were delighted to discover all the adoptions for the month of December, made soup for one of her church's Wednesday Lenten suppers, and baked cookies for their Family Choir Christmas Party!
