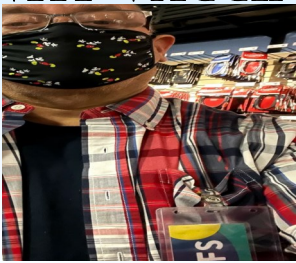

My name is Juan Burgos and I got my 1st Dose COVID-19 vaccine. I feel great and I can sleep better, knowing that I am a little safer. I am just one step for the 2nd COVID-19 vaccine, and I feel I help myself and others by getting vaccinated. The injection itself does not hurt at all. Right after you get it, they will send you to a room with more staff to monitor your reaction for at least 15 minutes. This is just to make sure you do not have any reaction, so they can help you right away.

I feel great and I can sleep in peace. My encouragement to all CFS staff in general is take it, do it, and be safe. Thank you, to all CFS supervisors, staff, managers and administration for helping me to get the vaccine COVID-19.
