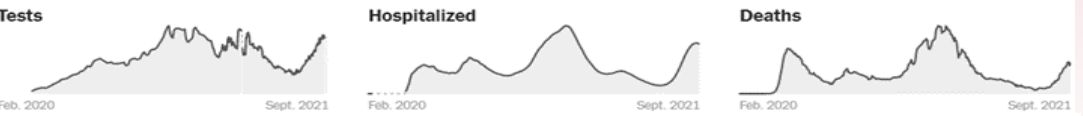




COVID-19 POSITIVE CASES/HOSPITALIZATIONS/DEATH TRENDS

We are seeing an increase in new reported COVID-19 cases across the country as well as among our CFS staff. The trends also are showing increases in hospitalizations and deaths. Preventing COVID-19 continues to be extremely important. Getting vaccinated, wearing face covering and maintaining social distance are all important tools.

VACCINATION TRENDS

We are seeing an increase in eligible adults being vaccinated across the country. This is a positive trend, but we need to act faster for this to make a difference now. We are still seeing vaccine hesitancy among our CFS staff and have not seen much of an increase in NY. Although, we have seen an increase in staff being vaccinated in NJ, as there are new vaccine/testing mandates.
